The TWIN II ACRO was built with elevator rod II, Part-Number 103A-4241. The tubing material for this elevator rod is no longer available in the required length. With this optional Service Bulletin the installation of the alternate elevator rod II, PN 103A-4241/2, made from different material, is permitted.


#### 1.7 Approval Note:

### 1.8 Accomplishment / Instructions:

- 1.8.1. For spar parts order only elevator rod II, part number 103A-4241/2 with steel tubing dia.20 x 0,8 millimetres can be delivered. Because of that, the rod length and dimensions will not change.
- 1.8.2. A new weight and balance report must be generated and incorporated into the Flight Manual. For details see 1.10.

#### 1.10 Mass (Weight) and CG:

The new elevator rod 103A-4241/2 is 0,73kg (1,60 lbs) heavier. After installation the empty weight as well as the centre of gravity of the glider will change.



In case ballast is installed in the tail, after installation of the new rod 103A-4241/2 it can be reduced or removed if the new centre of gravity will allow so.
